PUBLICATIONS AND RESEARCH

- There is little literature on seafarers' mental health, especially in developing countries.
- Lack of sufficient criteria for mental health screening in the recruitment process and job qualifications is also noticeable.

PUBLICATIONS AND RESEARCH IN THE IMH

- An increase in the mental health publications has been observed in period from 2021 to 2023
- The archives of the articles in the IMH have been analyzed by the IMH Editorial Team with focus on the mental health papers.

OFFICER SUPPLY SHORTFALL

- Manning Annual Review and Forecast (Drewry, 2023) Officer supply shortfall has reached a record high and is not expected to improve,
- The 2023 officer availability gap has widened to a deficit equating to about 9% of the global pool, which represents the highest level since 17 years ago
- The importance of wellbeing has come to the forefront in employee retention, and the trend of looking beyond wage rates is becoming stronger by the day.
- Things like good communication channels with families at home, comfortable facilities onboard and a supportive work environment are gaining importance.
